### **Board of Director Meeting**

September 15, 2015

### Call to order

The general membership meeting of the Meridian Park PTSA was called to order in the Meridian Park Library at 7:00 PM by the PTSA president Jill Steinberg. Members had been informed of the meeting through the MP and PTSA websites, MP PTSA Facebook page and MP email blast.

### Welcome and introductions

Everyone was welcomed and introduced themselves. Those present are listed on the attached attendance sheet.

# Review and Approval of minutes from June 4, 2015 BOD meeting

The 06/04/15 minutes were distributed and reviewed. A motion was made and seconded to approve the minutes. The minutes were approved as written.

# President's report

Review of current PTSA roster including open positions and roster contact information.

### Treasurer's report

Reviewed year-end financial report for 2014-2015. To be submitted for approval at General Membership meeting in October.

Review of 2015-2016 budget before submitting for approval at the General Membership meeting in October.

Discussion regarding two different plans presented: Plan A gives us all we want with small surplus, Plan B reduces funding and has large surplus (was in place not knowing revenue for car show).

Jill and Matt recommend we go with Plan A as car show revenue was all time high and we are able to balance budget with all funding still in place. All in agreement to move forward with presenting Plan A in general membership meeting.

Fall Fundraiser overhead cost decreased significantly because we are changing to different type of fundraiser. Moving to direct ask fundraiser.

# Principal's report

Meridian Park has approximately 564 students this year, about 100 new families on first day. School is at 95% capacity. There are also several staff changes including new staff this year. David currently finalizing part-time staffing.

Curriculum night is Thursday September 17, 2015.

Shoreline School District board is looking at doing capacity study this fall. This may mean changes. District wide the elementary schools are full. The school board is possibly looking at new middle schools.

Cascade K-8 is looking to move to their own site. If this happens it may affect our capacity.

No transfer requests are allowed at this time. David may be allowed to approve some resident transfer requests if there is space in classroom and sibling currently attends Meridian Park (as per board policy). ELL students were moved out of Meridian Park and back to their home school due to board change (ELL program is now available at all schools)

Conferences to be held Oct 14-16, early release on those days.

School has been working on positive behaviour and self management, this is going very well and the teachers are seeing positive results. Also working on incorporating Brain Breaks into the classrooms as research about stretching and exercising stimulates the brain.

# 2015-2016 Strategic Goals approval

Strategic goals were reviewed

A motion was made and seconded to approve the strategic goals as outlined. Goals approved.

### Standing rules

Review of 2015-2016 Standing Rules. Members reviewed the rules. They will be submitted for approval at General Membership meeting in October.

At the PTA convention in April they decided to make change of UNIT to LOCAL PTSA and GENERAL MEMBERSHIP to MEMBERSHIP. This is the only change to the Standing Rules.
